EVENT	WHAT YOU SHOULD DO
<p>Upon request, an electronic copy of this Building's Emergency Action Plan (BEAP) can be provided.</p> <p>Please contact the University's Emergency Management Coord. at 330-972-2633 to request a copy.</p>	<p>Call University of Akron Police Department (UAPD) at 330-972-2911</p> <p>Be prepared to share:</p> <p>Exit the building using closest portable fire extinguishers.</p> <p>Report to your designated evacuation rally point.</p> <p>3/4 Run via elevated bridge</p> <p>3/4 Run if you are able to escape from the building then do so. If you are unable to escape, then you may try to extinguish the fire. If you are unable to escape, then you may try to extinguish the fire.</p> <p>Notify UAPD once you are in a safe location.</p> <p>HIDE - If escape is not possible, find a good place to hide, lock the door if possible, turn off lights and silence your cell phones. Prepare a defense if the attacker enters the room.</p> <p>FIGHT - Find items to throw at the attacker's head (books, chairs, fire extinguisher, etc.). As a last resort, be prepared to ambush the attacker and secure the weapon in a trash can.</p> <p>Notification - Information will be provided to you by text, indoor notification systems. Use this information to make good decisions.</p>

<p>Medical Emergency</p>	<p>Provide the dispatcher: your name, type of emergency, location of the victim(s), condition of the victim(s), any dangerous conditions. Clear the area and have someone monitor the injured person until EMS arrives.</p> <p>Comfort and reassure injured person.</p> <p>3/4 An AED is located outside the second-floor recital hall.</p>
<p>Power Outage</p>	<p>Turn off and unplug computers and any electronic equipment.</p> <p>Move cautiously to lighted area.</p> <p>Stay in lit area until given the order to evacuate or the power comes back on.</p>
